### Coach Baker Leaves 'Sharks After Seven Successful Years

Original 'Shark Rod Baker accepted a coaching offer late last year from the D-League's Bakersfield Jam. Baker had been Rochester's only coach throughout all of the franchise's first seven seasons. He led the team to four championships in six playoff attempts- totaling an all-time record of 148-36 (.804). Twice, the 'Sharks won 16 games in a row. His 'Sharks were undefeated at home in two straight years and posted a home winning streak high of 48 consecutive games. The 'Sharks once won 12 consecutive away games. His teams finished first in regular season play three times, and never lower than third. He was named Coach of the Year three times.

## Great Moments at the BCA at the Rochester War Memorial

*With the pending RazorSharks move to Henrietta and a new home basketball court next year, here's a look at some of the more exciting and unforgettable moments provided by the city's professional team during their play in downtown Rochester, since 2005....*

### **March 26, 2006, One-for-One- 'Sharks Are Champs in First Season**

After a 23-year absence, pro ball returns to Rochester; and the 'Sharks finish off the American Basketball Association campaign in style! Before a season-high crowd of 6,377, Rochester beats Southern California, 117-114 for the crown. Down by nine points at halftime- and Lazarus Sims saddled with five fouls, Rochester rallies behind Demond Stewart's game high 27 points. Playoff MVP Chris Carrawell bags 23, including the final three points on clutch free throws. "We made it tough on ourselves," says Chris afterward. "But it's sweeter this way!" The 'Sharks lead the league in attendance and COO/General Manager Orest Hrywnak is named the ABA's Executive of the Year.

### **March 30, 2008, 'Sharks Take PBL Crown – Sammy Breaks Backboard**

The RazorSharks join the new Premier Basketball League, go undefeated at home at the BCA, and take the one-game finale over Arkansas for the title, 142-112. A still-standing record crowd of 9,717 root the team on. With just two minutes gone in the first quarter, Sammy Monroe goes strong to the hoop and breaks the backboard glass. The resulting crystal shower pours over James Reaves, but he waits until after the game to get stitches. "It was kinda scary because glass got in my eyes," he tells the *Democrat and Chronicle*. "But I couldn't *not* play in that game!" Reaves stays on the court for almost 33 minutes and scores 19. Rochester's 73 first half points is a club record. Game MVP Keith Friel tallies a personal high of 35 points together with a franchise best seven three-pointers. This is Demond Stewart's last appearance with the 'Sharks, having played in each of the team's 85 games over three seasons.

### **April 19, 2009, Back-to-Back Champions- Sammy Does it Again**

A season-high crowd of 7,119 witness Rochester's second-straight romp for the title, this time: a 152-115 thrashing of Battle Creek. Incredibly, Sammy Monroe shatters *another* backboard- during a breakaway dunk, causing more than an hour delay to the game. Eight 'Sharks score into double figures, led by Keith Friel's 28 points. He and Monroe (25 points) share Playoff MVP honors. Rochester's 72 team rebounds hasn't been topped since. Bob Matthews writes in his *Democrat and Chronicle* column that Rochester repeated because they "had the deepest team" had the "best coach" (Rod Baker) and the "front office and support staff are best in the league."

### **March 28, 2009, 'Sharks Score 101 in First Half, 176 For the Game**

[see article elsewhere in this Guide] Rochester sets a multitude of records by crushing Chicago, 176-96. With the crowd chanting "We want one-hundred," James Reaves drains a jumper to give the 'Sharks 101 points in the first half alone. The 176 points is the highest ever attained for a city pro sports team.

### **January 10, 2009, 'Sharks Win 48 Home Games in a Row at the BCA**

James Reaves leads both sides with 27 points and 14 rebounds as Rochester beats Buffalo, 120-100 in the 2008-09 home opener. With this victory the 'Sharks have won 48 consecutive games in Rochester. It's a streak that began November 25, 2005 and includes undefeated *seasons* in 2006-07 and 2007-08. The winning run ends in the 'Sharks next home game, January 19 to Vermont 113-110. The undefeated BCA stretch endures for 1,151 days.

## **December 7, 2006, Sims' Triple-Double Dumps Detroit 115-100**

Just two days earlier, Rochester loses on the road to Detroit by nine points- a 'Sharks effort that Coach Baker recalls years later as among his top disappointments. Guard Lazarus Sims personally enacts revenge as Detroit visits Rochester. "Z" produces the only 'Sharks triple-double to date, scoring 12 points and leading the team in rebounds (11) and assists (14- second-most ever for Rochester- see section here for Sims' 21 assist game). Rochester is off and running with a 33-14 first quarter lead. The 'Sharks defense limits Detroit to only 38% accuracy from the field. James Reaves leads Rochester with 22 points, connecting on 9 of 14 shots from the field.

## **March 6, 2011, Walton's Last-Second Dunk Sinks Lawton-Fort Sill**

The usual nail-biter with arch-rival Lawton-Fort Sill has 3.9 seconds to go in the fourth quarter. Coach Baker breaks the time out huddle with a plan: have Keith Friel screen off a defender, allowing Eric Walton free passage to the basket. The inbounds pass- the "alley-ooop"- by Jerice Crouch is on the money and Walton dunks over the late-arriving foe. The BCA fans go wild over the 'Sharks 93-91 victory. "Picture-perfect," Walton says later. "Just how we drew it up." (See The Walton Dunk on the last page of this Guide)

## **February 22, 2007, The World's Tallest Basketball Player... and Moe**

At 7-feet 9-inches tall, China's 23-year old Sun Ming Ming fills his size 20 sneakers for the visiting Maryland Nighthawks. Many of the 6,812 fans in attendance have come to gawk at the sight. He's "tall enough to change a gymnasium's light bulbs without a ladder," surmises the *Democrat and Chronicle's* Scott Pitoniak. The 370-pound Sun labors up and down the floor, plays 15 minutes and scores four points with nine rebounds. He dwarfs the opposing center, Rochester's 6'8" James Reaves. But Reaves (30 points, 16 rebounds) wins the battle. "I took it as a personal challenge to try and overcome his huge size advantage," Reaves says after the game. And Rochester wins the war, 131-102. Also in the lineup for the 'Sharks tonight is their "Celebrity 13th Man." It's part of a league promotion allowing a citizen to play and Rochester's East End Association President Moe Alaimo is wearing number 12. Coach Baker finally gives in to the "We want Moe!" chants from the fans. Alaimo loses the ball for a turnover but also scores two points.

## **February 11, 2007, Sims Delivers All-Time 'Sharks Record 21 Assists**

An exhausting plane schedule includes a trip to Western New York for the Hollywood Fame. The 'Sharks run to a 38-14 lead after one quarter. And Lazarus Sims takes full advantage, passing off for 21 assists in Rochester's 131-89 victory. Keith Friel goes along for the ride with a game high 27 points, including a club-record seven three pointers. "He (Sims) was finding me all day," Friel tells the *Democrat and Chronicle*. "So it was just catch and shoot."

## **December 31, 2005- Four-Point Shot Nearly Dooms 'Sharks**

The final score shows Rochester winning by one point, 101-100 over Harlem. But there's much more to the story. With less than ten seconds remaining in the fourth quarter and the 'Sharks ahead by five, fans are ready to ring in the New Year on a happy note. But suddenly, a beyond-half-court-heave by the visitor's John Halas goes in- and he is fouled by the 'Sharks Eric Walton. The ABA league rule awards Harlem four points for the basket, plus a foul shot. It is only after Halas' free throw clanks off the front rim that Rochester enjoys victory. "Just trying to give people their money's worth," jokes 'Sharks Coach Rod Baker afterward. Halas goes on to play the next three years in Rochester, scoring 37 three-pointers at the BCA (yet no more of the four-point variety).

## **RazorSharks Score 101 Points in 1st Half of 176-96 Victory**

The date: Saturday March, 28, 2009. The place: the Blue Cross Arena at the Rochester War Memorial. The event: the Rochester RazorSharks most dominating performance in club history; the day the 'Sharks scored 101 points in the first half, on the way to a 176-96 pounding of the Chicago Throwbacks.

Just 4 seconds after the 'Sharks won the opening tap, guard Keith Friel nailed a three-pointer- and the demolition began. Public address announcer Dino Kay was at the mike. "I was calling all of the scores and it seemed like everything we put up went in. It was just one of those special days."

After one quarter, the 'Sharks led 52-27- led by an amazing 22 points from Friel (including five 3-pointers) and 10 points from Sammy Monroe. "Chicago had traveled and they were willing to allow it," says Rod Baker, Rochester's coach at the time. "We had it going and they didn't. And we made shots- it's not like we had a lot of layups. We made shots from all over the floor."

Center James Reaves says the excitement inside the BCA that night rivaled the final game of 2006 when the RazorSharks claimed their first league title. For the players, the night of the 176 points evolved into a real 'Sharks feeding frenzy. "It was contagious," Reaves says. "And we were feeding off of the fans because they were seeing something exciting and we were a part of that."

Friel had his best day ever as a 'Shark with 36 points (only two points from Chris Carrawell's Rochester record of 38). Keith shot an incredible 80% from the floor (12-for-15 including a 'Sharks record 9 of 10 three-pointers!). "I remember feeling good," Friel recalls. "Like I couldn't miss. During a timeout, one of the Chicago players said to me: 'I feel like we're playing the Celtics right now- this is ridiculous!' ". Henrietta, New York's Roger Gross has been a RazorSharks season ticket holder since the team began. "When Friel got hot, you knew the ball was going in," he says. "The other team would've had to throw a net over Keith to keep him covered!"

With one minute to go in the second quarter, Marlin Johnson scored a bucket to push Rochester to 99 points. The 4,226 fans were on their feet as the clock ticked under thirty seconds. 'Sharks Assistant Coach Chris Iversen remembers, "I never heard that building as loud as it was when Sammy Monroe waited on Mook (James Reaves) for a little pick-and-pop." From the right side of the foul line, Reaves used the Monroe screen to get open and drained a 17-footer, sending Rochester over the century mark. Only 16 seconds remained in the half. The arena buzzed with wonder and excitement throughout the halftime intermission. Fans wowed at the 101 points on the scoreboard.

After three quarters, Rochester led Chicago 140-79. The 'Sharks then out-scored the Throwbacks 36-17 in the fourth quarter, ending the 176-96 rout.

The 176 points remains as the most ever scored in city history for professional play. The Rochester Zeniths of the Continental Basketball Association previously held the record by tallying 172 points in 1981. The RazorSharks shot 63-96 against Chicago or 66%- still the franchise game high for FG percentage.

It was a game featuring eight different 'Sharks scoring into double-figures. Sammy Monroe brought home 26 and Reaves got 23- each firing 9-14 from the floor. John Halas was a perfect 7-7 from outside, scoring 18 points (including 4-for-4 on three pointers). Marlin Johnson passed off for a team-high 7 assists.

It was an astonishing display of basketball talent and execution. But most importantly, the milestone performance came in the midst of a championship season. Rochester would go on to claim the 2008-09 PBL crown.

## **RazorSharks Planning Move to Henrietta**

The Rochester RazorSharks are in the process of leaving their 8-year home at the BCA at the Rochester War Memorial. Pending favorable engineering reports, the ‘Sharks will begin play next year at the current Dome Arena site in Henrietta, New York. The Dome previously hosted professional basketball with the Rochester Zeniths of the Continental Basketball Association through parts of four seasons, between 1978-82. Rochester RazorSharks Owner and Executive CEO **Severko Hrywnak** addresses the team’s future...

### ***Why is the team leaving the Rochester downtown area and the BCA?***

We tried for years and it’s just way too cost-prohibitive to make any profit. It doesn’t make economic sense to play there. There’s too many chiefs. We’re paying so many people, it’s ridiculous. The city has a part of it, the SMG management [*concessions*] has a part of it, the Amerks [*Rochester’s hockey team*] have a part of it. And... we took dates like New Year’s Eve and Martin Luther King’s birthday- we said we’d make them work. We made them work and the Amerks took [those dates] this year.

### ***What is the cost in buying the Dome property and the needed improvements?***

We’ve guess-timated with purchase price and renovation, between 5 and 6 million. We want to add corporate suites, reconfigure the seating, put a scoreboard in, put a production room in, make it internet ready, improve the concession stand, possibly add a physical therapy center and a restaurant inside... so that adds up. The seats that we’ve designed will be internet-ready and they’ll include special chargers so you can plug in your phone or your I-pad right by your seats.

### ***Will other sports teams play at the Dome site? What will be the fan capacities?***

The indoor soccer Rochester Lancers are interested. We received a call from an indoor lacrosse league- they’d like to put a franchise in Rochester. We’re going to try to have a hockey rink available for high school and college hockey, basketball courts for high school and college events... and it’s not just sports, also: concerts and trade shows. For RazorSharks games the capacity will be 4,500 fans, and for concerts: around 6,000.

### ***Will there be a name change for the arena and grounds?***

We’ll be selling the naming rights and have been talking to people that we can’t disclose at this time. It’ll be called.. something, something at the Rochester Business and Sports Entertainment Center.

### ***What is the hopeful timetable in the coming months?***

There still are many things to be determined from an engineering standpoint. There is no financial problem, it’s more of: can the structure handle the changes we want to do. Construction would start a week after we close the deal- hopefully by the last week in April. Then, it’s about 120-150 days to get construction completed. We’re trying to figure how to maintain the same configuration but restructure it so we can add more seats, corporate suites and regular suites, along with the seats in the existing configuration. As far as hiring for jobs, everything will be local. We’ll try to engage as many people, locally, as possible.

I’m very, very excited, not only for the RazorSharks but for the community at large. We plan to do a lot of things for the community and the greater Rochester area.
